Day 2



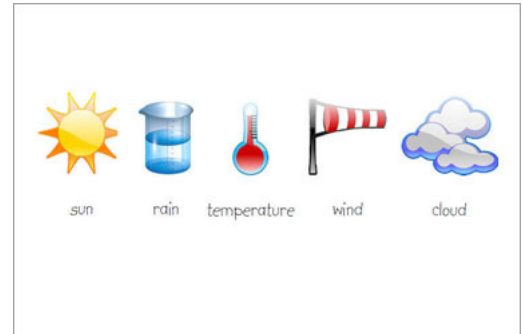
Listen to the Rain

- The Kids' Book of Weather Forecasting



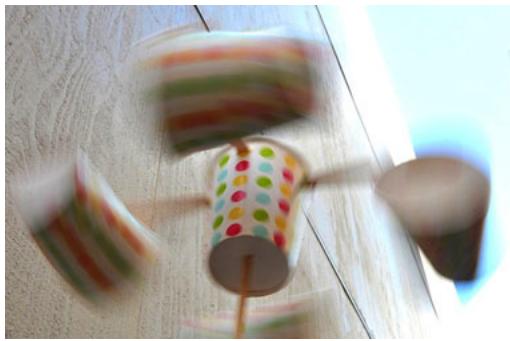
